Statement of Brooklyn District Attorney Ken Thompson on Sentencing of Defendant For Repeatedly Making Fake 911 Calls

"By repeatedly making fake 911 calls the defendant caused police officers to respond to his bogus claims, putting the lives and safety of people with real emergencies in jeopardy. This is no joke and he will now pay the price for his dangerous conduct."

The defendant, Louis Segna, 53, of Williamsburg, Brooklyn, was convicted of one count of first-degree falsely reporting an incident and two counts of third-degree falsely reporting an incident in August. He was sentenced today by Brooklyn Supreme Court Justice William Harrington to six months in jail and five years' probation.
