**Job Description**

The Kings County District Attorney's Office, located in the Merrotech area of Brooklyn, New York, is accepting applications for the position of Senior Clinical Supervisor for its Victim Services Unit. The Victim Services Unit provides counseling services and relocation programs for victims of crime who experience trauma.

The Duties of this position include:

Provide supervision to counselors, victim advocates, and interns within VSU on the provision of counseling services, safety planning, and administrative functions. Assess training needs of unit staff and make appropriate recommendations. Provide training and outreach to professionals and community groups. Assist with grants and program development as directed. Provide short-term counseling to victims in a variety of settings within the office.

**Minimum Qual Requirements**

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and two years of experience in community work or community centered activities in an area related to the duties described above; or
2. High school graduation or equivalent and six years of experience in community work or community centered activities in an area related to the duties as described above; or
3. Education and/or experience which is equivalent to "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least one year of experience as described in "1" above.

**Preferred Skills**

Currently be a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) Master's degree in social work and at least 4 years of direct work experience in the field of victim services. Must have SIFI certificate and previous experience providing clinical supervision. Bilingual ability and previous program supervisory experience are a plus.
