**Re: Annual Report on Criminal Prosecutions Pursuant to N.Y.C. Local Law 161  
(2021)**

Dear Mayor Mamdani, Speaker Menin, and Ms. Logan:

I write to submit the Brooklyn District Attorney's Office Annual Report on Criminal Prosecutions pursuant to Local Law 161 and to thank you for your continued partnership in advancing transparency, fairness, and public safety.

This year's report comes at a moment of real pride for Brooklyn. In 2025, our borough saw record low homicides and shootings, a remarkable public safety achievement that reflects the hard work of our prosecutors, professional staff, law enforcement partners, and community stakeholders. We are proud to share this report as part of that progress.

The report also reflects meaningful improvement in our own data gathering and analytics capacity. Thanks to the diligence and expertise of our team, we are now able to provide a more detailed, accurate, and useful account of prosecutorial activity and outcomes, drawing increasingly from our own internal systems. That progress has strengthened both our operations and our ability to share clearer information with policymakers, stakeholders, and the public.

At the same time, this report also underscores the structural underfunding that continues to limit our Office, especially in Information Technology, and still constrains our analytics capacity. Despite serving more than one million more residents than Manhattan and handling thousands more cases each year, Brooklyn receives 51 percent less funding per arrest than our peers in Manhattan, and our Information Technology Department is less than half the size of

theirs. That disparity makes it harder to build and maintain the modern data infrastructure needed to gather, analyze, and report this information at the level the law and the public rightly expect.

Even with those constraints, our staff has made substantial strides. With stronger investment which we have requested for FY2027, we could do far more. Additional support for technology, staffing, and data infrastructure would enhance our ability to collect and analyze the critical information reflected in this report, improve the precision and usefulness of future disclosures, and better equip our Office to meet both operational needs and legal reporting obligations.

We are grateful for your support and ask for your continued partnership so that Brooklyn can fully build on the progress reflected here.
